Show time in The Adria Marquee

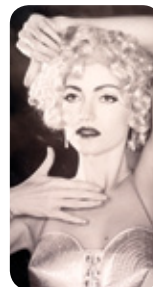

The American Divas

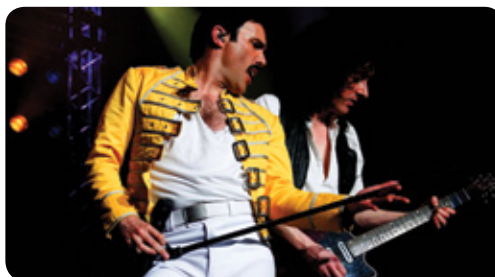

Sledmere House – East Yorkshire's finest Country House



The charm of Sledmere has captivated visitors for over 200 years. Whether you just want a relaxing day looking round the gardens, enjoy lunch in the Terrace Café, or viewing the fine examples of art and architecture there's something for everyone.

Designed by Samuel Wyatt and Sir Christopher Sykes, 2nd baronet and nurtured by successive generations, this very special place brings new devotees every year.

Sledmere is a Georgian House – and it is also an Edwardian House. Sir Christopher Sykes, 2nd baronet, rebuilt and redecorated the house in the 1790s, but in 1911 it was almost completely destroyed by fire. Fortunately most of the contents were rescued and can still be seen on view today.

It's worth a visit just to see the splendour of Joseph Rose's plasterwork and the fine

examples of furniture by Chippendale, Hepplewhite and Sheraton.

Situated in the centre of the Yorkshire Wolds, here is a place to eat, shop, walk, cycle or immerse yourself in the charms of stunning gardens, soak up the atmosphere of a much loved 'stately' home and explore the stables which are once again home to working horses.
